WHEREAS, prior to being named the top young farm family, they were selected as Top 10 finalists; and

WHEREAS, the Wendlands are only the second family from the State of Alabama to receive this achievement; and

WHEREAS, Drew serves Autauga Farming Company as its crop production manager, alongside other members of the family including his father Andy and his brother Dan; and

WHEREAS, Drew's wife Lauren is a nurse practitioner; however, outside of her regular employment she also supports the work on the farm; and

WHEREAS, Autauga Farming Company, truly is a family business incorporating multiple generations and branches of the Wendland family; and

WHEREAS, the Wendland family serves in numerous capacities from the Autauga County Farmers Federation, Alabama Farmers Federation (including its State Hay & Forage Committee), and other national and state entities; and

WHEREAS, Drew is a graduate of the elite Alabama Farmers Federation Leaders program Class V; and



WHEREAS, on October 7, 2025, the Autauga County Commission approved an action to terminate its contract with Avenu Insights and Analytics, LLC ; and

WHEREAS, the Autauga County Commission approved the County Administrator to enter into an agreement whereby the Alabama Department of Revenue would undertake the tax collection services offered by Avenue Insights and Analytics, LLC; and


WHEREAS, the Autauga County Commission desires to enter into a contract with the entity formally known as Avenue Insights and Analytics, LLC, now known as Neumo Group, LLC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Autauga County Commission does hereby rescind the termination of the agreement with Avenu Insights and Analytics, LLC from its October 7, 2025, revokes the authorization of the County Administrator to enter into an agreement with the Alabama Department of Revenue, and terminates any such agreements, and re-authorizes the Chairman and County Administrator to sign all documents necessary to enter into a Professional Services Agreement with Neumo Group, LLC, the entity formerly known as Avenu Insights and Analytics, LLC beginning March 1, 2026 through February 28, 2029.


