Whereas; we salute our troops for their outstanding efforts to preserve peace and to protect the vital interests of the United States; and





in Autauga County, Alabama we encourage all citizens to join in acknowledging and celebrating the men and women of the United States Armed Forces.

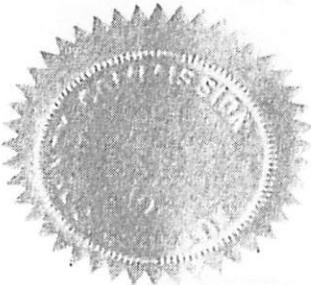
