RESOLUTION

(To Adopt Mandatory Garbage Collection Ordinance)

WHEREAS, the Autauga County Commission caused to be held a referendum held on November 7, 2006 to approve Autauga County's participation in Mandatory Garbage Collection for the County; and

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of November, 2006 the citizens in a referendum approved Mandatory Garbage Collection for the County by the authority granted to the Autauga County Commission under *Code of Ala. 1975*, Section 22-27-1, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Autauga County Commission finds that it is in the best interest of the Citizens of the county to adopt the rules and regulations of Code of Ala. 1975, Section 22-27-1, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Autauga County Commission finds that it is in the best interest of the Citizens of the county to adopt and implement rules and regulations regarding Mandatory Garbage Collection for the County in order to protect its citizens from public nuisances relating to public welfare, health and safety within the unincorporated areas of the county.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Autauga County Commission in accordance with the vote of the citizens of the county adopts the provisions of Code of Ala. 1975, Section 22-27-1, et seq and in particular Code of Ala. 1975, Section 22-27-3 to require Mandatory Garbage Collection within the unincorporated areas of the County and within the incorporated areas of the county which have elected to be included under said ordinance by appropriate procedure as provided by statute; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Autauga County Commission that this Ordinance shall be effective as of the 1st day of January, 2008; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Autauga County Commission that it shall adopt rules and regulations providing for mandatory public participation in and subscription to such system of services by appropriate resolution on or before the 1st day of January, 2008.
